

# **City of Wayne Residential Brush Chipping Program**

Effective August 1, 2007

The City of Wayne Department of Public Works will pick up and chip brush from residences in the City of Wayne between April 1 to October 1.

This program is available for City of Wayne residential properties only. Brush will not be picked up or chipped at vacant lots, businesses, commercial properties, apartment complexes or brush from activities performed by commercial contractors.

Residents requesting brush pick up must call the Department of Public Works to arrange for brush pick up. Brush chipping request limited to twice per year per residence.

All brush must be properly prepared as described below. Brush that is not properly prepared will not be picked up and will be the responsibility of the resident.

Once on the schedule, brush will be picked up by City of Wayne crews within one week under normal conditions.

## **Brush Preparation**

Brush limbs must be 4 feet or longer with a diameter of 4 inches or less.

Brush must be stacked with all of the cut ends towards the street or parallel to the street. If the area between the sidewalk and the curb is too narrow, place brush in yard just inside the sidewalk.

The brush pile can not be bundled and must be free of any other material (roots, vines, grass, fencing, metal, concrete or other foreign materials) Do not stack brush over 3 foot high or extend pile onto sidewalk or street.

No roots, vines, logs, branches over 4" in diameter or less than 4' in length, trunks, stumps, or branches with thorns on them will be picked up.
